What is a call for papers?

An abstract is submitted to ensure you and the attendee get the best value from your presentation at Smarter Mobility Africa. Only the best papers will be marked and included in the SMA 2023 agenda/programme.

Who marks all the abstracts?

The papers are marked by senior, influential and thought-leaders of the industry from our SMA Advisory Board.

What criteria to follow?

Your abstract is marked based on 2 categories: Innovation and Relevance

Innovation – How exciting is this technology or solution?

- Novelty/vision
- Originality
- Potential for impact in the industry

Relevance – Does your topic fit within the Smarter Mobility Africa themes

- Evidence of operating experience
- Regional relevance, practicality and operability
- Soundness
- Strength of validation
- Quality of presentation
- Industrial case studies with valuable lessons learned
- Clear takeaways and learning outcomes realised



Guideline Topics

Abstracts should be no more than 100 words and should be written and submitted in English (following the submission process).

- Prior to submission all relevant approvals, clearance and availability to attend must be in place. Any issues concerning approval or clearance should be outlined when the abstract is submitted.
- If the abstract has been presented previously, details of when and where need to be provided in the submission form

If accepted:

- You will be notified by the end of May/ early June
- A draft version of the presentation will be required prior to the event for review by the SMA Advisory Board who will check the content for relevance and commercial content. Please note sales pitches are not allowed unless you are partnered with the event commercially.
- Presentations must be prepared in line with our presentation guidelines which will be distributed upon notification of acceptance.

Additional Tips

The Call for Papers process can be competitive. Make sure to fill the form out properly – what you write will be seen by our Advisors.

- Don't present topics which have been presented elsewhere, at least without a new spin as you will lose points on innovation.
- Think of how your audience will engage with your presentation and how this information will help make mobility smarter in Africa. Add 3 takeaways that are clear on the value the presentation brings.
- Please note sales pitches are not allowed.
- Case studies and real-life examples also score highly over theoretical presentations.
- **Don't miss the deadline!**
